(i) Maruthuvam- 10 seats, (ii) Gunapadam- 10 seats, (iii) Sirappu Maruthuvam - 10 seats, (iv) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam -10 seats, (v) Noi Naadal and Noi Mudhal Naadal- 10 seats and (vi) Nanju Noolum Maruthuvam Neethi Noolum-10 seats **under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 for the academic session 2018-19** -reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No. R-17013/03/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 31.8.2017, related to admission matter for the year 2018-19 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic session 2018-19.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on **01-02.06.2018** to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard of Siddha Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations, several deficiencies have been found. However, the CCIM has recommended for granting conditional permission for admission with **100 seats in BSMS (UG) Course and 60 seats in 06 PG courses** viz. (i) Maruthuvam- 10 seats, (ii) Gunapadam- 10 seats, (iii) Sirappu Maruthuvam - 10 seats, (iv) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam -10 seats, (v) Noi Naadal and Noi Mudhal Naadal- 10 seats and (vi) Nanju Noolum Maruthuvam Neethi Noolum-10 seats for the academic session 2018-19 subject to furnishing of undertaking from Secretary/Director/Commissioner of the Department of

AYUSH/ISM of the State Government with an assurance that they will comply with the shortcomings within three months.

3. After receiving of undertaking vide reference no.8866/E1/1/2015-dated 05.07.2018 submitted by the **Director of Indian medicine and Homeopathy, Chennai** to the Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi. It has, therefore, been decided to **grant conditional permission to the Government Siddha Medical College, 2, Langarkana Street, Palayamkottai, Tirunelveli-627002, Tamil Nadu with 100 seats in BSMS (UG) Course and 60 seats in 06 PG courses viz. (i) Maruthuvam- 10 seats, (ii) Gunapadam- 10 seats, (iii) Sirappu Maruthuvam – 10 seats, (iv) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam -10 seats, (v) Noi Naadal and Noi Mudhal Naadal- 10 seats and (vi) Nanju Noolum Maruthuvam Neethi Noolum-10 seats for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 subject to rectification of the following deficiencies within three months as undertaken by the State Government;**

- i. The HF is not available in the dept. Gunapadam- Maruthakaviyal against the minimum requirement of 01 each as per RMS, 2016.
- ii. The required numerical teacher student ratio and at least 1 HF + 1 Lecturer in addition to the UG requirement is available in all PG departments for grant of conditional permission except in the Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam, Nanju Noolum department as per PG regulations, 2016.
- iii. 01 Lab Technician, Lab Assistant, Attendant are not available in the Gunapadam- Marumphakaviyal, Noi Naadal and Nanju Maruthuvam department in addition to UG requirement for PG course as per PG regulations, 2016.
- iv. Central research Lab & Animal House is not available for PG course as per PG regulations, 2016.
- v. Functionality of Clinical Laboratory, X-Ray, ECG and USG not available as per RMS, 2016.
- vi. Web based Computerized Central Registration system & Computerized Central Registration is not available as per RMS, 2016.
- vii. Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system is not available for teaching staff, non-teaching staff and hospital staff as required, as per decision dated 31.01.2018 and policy decision dated 15.06.2018 in place of Biometric Attendance as per sub-regulation (3) of regulation 9 of MSR.

4. The College is also directed that the following requirements should be fulfilled by the college positively by the 31st December, 2018, which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2019-2020 onwards:

- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016 by 31st December 2018.



- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
- (iii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and
- (iv) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.

5. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify by means of an inspection that the conditions have been fulfilled and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the session 2019-20.



Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No. R.17013/03/2018-EP (IM-1) dated 04.09.2018 related to permission matter for the academic year 2018-19 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic year 2019-20.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 13-14.03.2019 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, certain deficiencies have been observed and therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 17.05.2019 to present the case.

3. The observations of hearing committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Siddha Colleges and attached Hospitals and Post Graduate Siddha Medical Education) Regulations, 2016”, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) and it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting Conditional Permission for UG (BSMS) course and PG courses.

4. Therefore, it has been decided by the Central Government to grant Conditional Permission to Government Siddha Medical College, 2, Langarkana Street, Palayamkottai, Tirunelveli-627002, Tamil Nadu for conducting 100 seats in UG (BSMS) course and 60 seats in 06 PG courses viz. (i) Maruthuvam, (ii) Gunapadam, (iii) Sirappu Maruthuvam, (iv) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam, (v) Noi Naadal and (vi) Nanju Maruthuvam with 10 seats in each subject for the academic session 2019-20 under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970.

5. It is further informed that 15% of undergraduate seats and postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 UG seats and 60 PG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the said Counseling Authority to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.

7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCIM and the Central Government.

8. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2019 to get permission for the session 2020-21:

- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Siddha Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Siddha);
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*; and
- (iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Siddha Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.

9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to CCIM under intimation to this Ministry. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2020-21.

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's letter No. P-14014/8/2019-EP (I) dated 11.06.2019 related to admission matter for the academic year 2019-20 intimating certain requirements to be fulfilled by the college for consideration of permission for the academic session 2020-21.

2. Further, refer to the CCIM's letter No.Ref:18-12/2020.Siddha (C-01) dated 23.10.2020 forwarding therewith recommendation of the college to the Central Government based on thorough examination of the visitation report Part-I, indemnity bond, affidavit & latest details of teaching, non-teaching and hospital staff submitted by the college along with the assessment report, as the physical verification by conduction of inspection could not be carried out in view of present COVID-19 pandemic situation for the A.Y. 2020-21. On examining the same in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Siddha Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Siddha Education) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder, it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting Conditional Permission for UG (BSMS) course and 06 PG Courses.

3. Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provisions of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government notified that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. In view of the above the Central Government constituted the Autonomous Boards with effect from 11th June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder.

Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM ACT 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. However, GOI, Ministry of AYUSH vide its letter no. L.14011/3/2020-EP (1) dated 26.03.2021 and 15.04.2021 issued Relaxation/support policy for ASU&S colleges in unprecedented times of COVID-19 pandemic for the academic session 2021-22 and the permission for the academic year 2021-22 of the ASU&S colleges will be considered on the basis of part-I visitation proforma submitted by the college provided that the college shall submit an undertaking & indemnity bond, stating that they shall fulfill respective requirements in terms of required teaching and training facilities specified in the relevant regulations throughout the academic year".

Further, in view of above, the college has been assessed on the basis of Relaxation policy issued by the Ministry of AYUSH and on examining in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Siddha Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Siddha Education) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, it is found that the College was not fulfilling notified and approved criteria for Granting Conditional Permission for UG (BSMS) course and PG Courses A.Y. 2021-22.

Further, on examining the same, certain deficiencies have been observed and therefore, under section 28/29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, **an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 20.12.2021 to present the case through virtual mode.**

The observations of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Siddha Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", IMCC Post graduate Regulations (Siddha) 2016, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting Conditional Permission for 125 seats UG (BSMS) course and 75 Seats in 06 PG courses.

2. Therefore, it has been decided by the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine **to grant Conditional Permission to Govt. Siddha Medical College, Palayamkottai Tirunelveli-627002, Tamil Nadu. (Inst. Id: SID0266) with 125 seats (including EWS seats) in UG (BSMS) course and 75 Seats (including EWS seats) in 06 PG courses namely (i) Noi Naadal-12 seats (including EWS), (ii) Maruthuvam-12 seats (including EWS), (iii) Gunapadam -13 seats (including EWS), (iv) Sirappu Maruthuvam-13 seats (including EWS), and (v) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam -13seats (including EWS) and (vi) Nanju noolum Maruthuvam Neethi Noolum -12 (including EWS seats) seats for the academic session 2021-22** subject to the following conditions:-

- I. The fulfillment of conditions as specified in the Undertaking/Indemnity bond submitted by the college.
- II. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

3. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 125 UG (BSMS) seats and 75 seats in 06 PG Courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2021-22 and counseling for the remaining 85% of (UG & PG) seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.

6. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2021 to get permission for the session 2022-23:

- (i) all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Siddha Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Siddha); and
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
- (iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Siddha Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.

7. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission from the academic session 2022-23.

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

1. This is with reference to the first appeal filed by the Principal, Govt. Siddha Medical College, Langarkana Street, Palayamkottai, Tirunelveli, Tamil Nadu (Inst. ID SID0266), vide Ref. no- 687/ME1/2021, dated 21.10.2022 to the Commission in respect of Denial of Conditional Permission issued to Govt. Siddha Medical College, Langarkana Street, Palayamkottai, Tirunelveli, Tamil Nadu (Inst. ID SID0266) for conducting UG and PG courses as the case may be due to not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder due to non availability of teaching staff, as mentioned in denial order dated 18.10.2022.
2. Thereafter the said appeal was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and Chairman NCISM constituted a Hearing Committee and provided an opportunity of hearing to the college. Accordingly, the letter was sent to The Principal of the college vide Commission's letter no. NCISM/Comm./Appeal/(2022-23) dated 08.11.2022 to appear before the designated hearing committee as constituted by the Chairman, NCISM on 09.11.2022 in respect of appeal filed under section 10(1)(g) and section 24(3) of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020 and to produce all relevant valid documents/records/ proof to substantiate the claims and make written submission and submit an authenticated copy of evidence/verifications to commission with shortcoming wise clarifications mentioned in the denial orders dated 18.10.2022 passed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM. The proceedings of appeal was held virtually on 09.11.2022 at 03:00 PM and on behalf of the college, Dr. Shanta Maria, Principal, attended the hearing.
3. The hearing committee sought clarification from the representative of the college regarding the shortcomings mentioned in the denial orders dated 18.10.2022 passed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM, which is as under:-

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Proceeding of hearing committee

- Committee asked Dr. Santha Maria, Principal of the college, to inform the steps taken by them in respect of their appeal. In response of the same principal assured the committee that all the shortcomings mentioned will be complied before 31st December 2022.
- Further, she told that the Departmental Promotion Committee will be held soon to promote the faculty to higher posts i.e. 2 Readers will be promoted as Professors, 7 Lecturers will be promoted as Readers and extra PG staff available in college will also be promoted as Lecturers.
- Committee asked to submit affidavit regarding their assurance of fulfilling faculty. The essential recruitment and also other shortcomings signed by appointing authority and director of Ayush Tamil Nadu.
- Appellant requested to give all UG and PG seats to the mentioned colleges as they are going to fulfill all the vacancies and will comply all shortcomings before 31st December 2022.
- Committee received the submission with promotion of the staff after hearing along with affidavit and the committee considered the same.

- The submission made by the College was placed before the designated hearing committee and hearing committee sought clarification regarding the shortcomings mentioned in the denial order dated **18.10.2022** and also asked for the compliance of Shortcomings in respect of fulfillment of all requisite criteria as mentioned in the denial order.
- In response of the same, **the Principal, Govt. Siddha Medical College, Langarkana Street, Palayamkottai, Tirunelveli, Tamil Nadu- 627002** submitted the compliance letter vide Ref no. 687/ME1/2021 on 28.10.2022 with promotion of the staff after hearing along with affidavit of appointed teachers. The Hearing committee scrutinized the submissions & compliance reports & found that the shortcomings of teaching staff is complied except for the shortcoming of one Higher faculty for PG in department of Sattam Saarntha Maruthuvamum Nanju Maruthuvamum (Forensic Medicine & Toxicology)
- Hence, in view of the above, the Chairman, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM vide no. NCISM/Comm./Appeal/(2022-23) dated 23.11.2022 to grant Conditional Permission to **Govt. Siddha Medical College, Langarkana Street, Palayamkottai, Tirunelveli, Tamil Nadu (Inst. ID SID0266) for intake capacity of 100 seats (125 including EWS) in UG (BSMS) course & 60 PG seats (75 PG seats including EWS) in 08 PG courses namely, i) Maruthuvam- 10 seats (12 seats including EWS), ii) Gunapadam-10 seats (13 seats including EWS), iii) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam- 10 seats (13 seats including EWS), iv) Nanju Maruthuvam- 10 seats (12 seats including EWS), v) Noi naadal- 10 seats (12 seats including EWS), vi) Pura Maruthuvam- 03 seats (04 seats including EWS), vii) Siddhar Yoga Maruthuvam- 04 seats (05 seats including EWS), & viii) Varma Maruthuvam- 03 seats (04 seats including EWS), under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23.**
